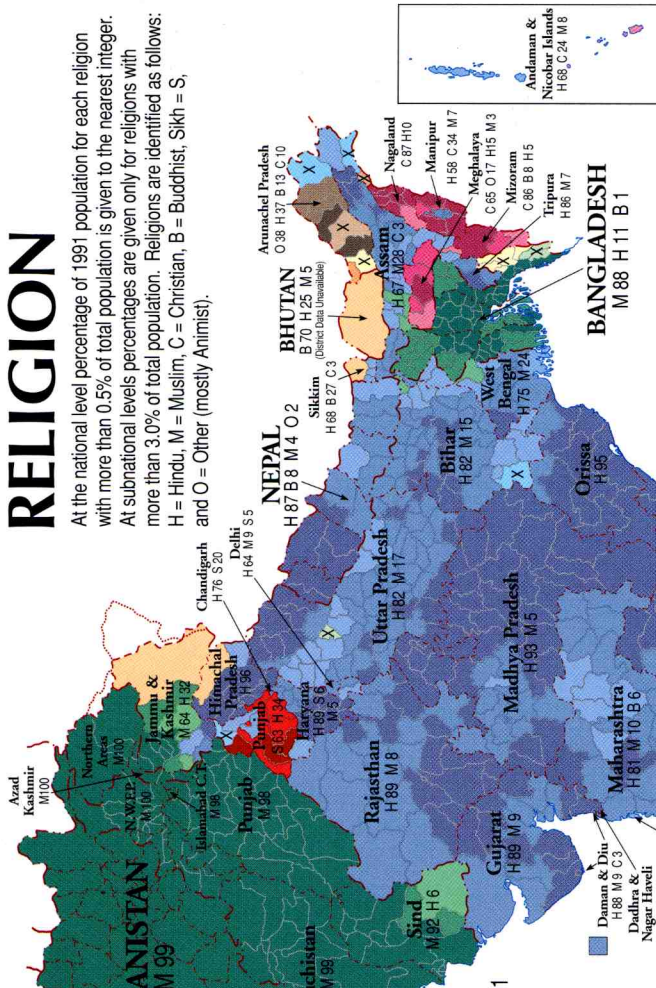
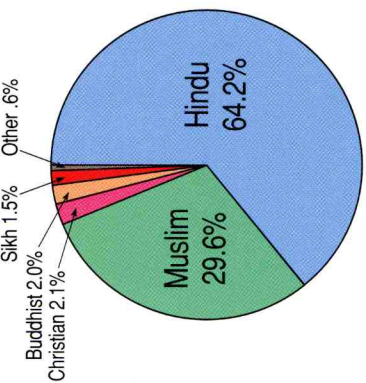


RELIGION

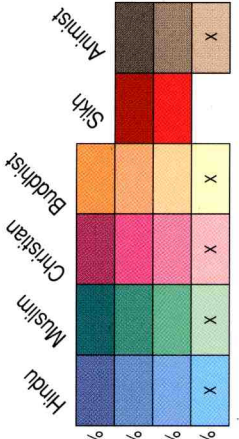
At the national level percentage of 1991 population for each religion with more than 0.5% of total population is given to the nearest integer. At subnational levels percentages are given only for religions with more than 3.0% of total population. Religions are identified as follows: H = Hindu, M = Muslim, C = Christian, B = Buddhist, Sikh = S, and O = Other (mostly Animist).
